

Your Intro Flight Lesson Starts with a walk around outside of the Aircraft with your Flight Instructor. He will go through all the Primary Flight Controls; how they work and their uses. He will also give you some brief insight to the Aerodynamics that makes the Aircraft Fly. Also included is brief history of General Aviation.



Next you will Climb in the Aircraft and have a brief lesson on the flight controls inside.



After the plane is started your Instructor will direct you on how to taxi the plane. You will be able to taxi it to the runway.

After a pre-takeoff briefing on how to take the Aircraft Off you will take the airplane down the runway and lift it off into the air. During climb-out to Altitude you will be shown the use of the Flight Controls that will direct you through the rest of your flight.

During the flight at about 1000 feet over Newburgh and Evansville you will have full control of the aircraft. Your Instructor will be HANDS-OFF as you fly your own tour over the area.



After about a 15-20 min flight around town, you will approach the airport for landing. With your Instructors help you will land the plane.

After landing you will use everything you have learned to taxi in to complete the lesson.

After the Lesson you can ask all the questions you want to your Instructor. He will be happy to answer them. Flying is our passion and love to share it. The complete lesson will keep you at the airport for 45min to 1 hour with about 30min of total flight time. The flight can be logged into a logbook as your first flight towards your Pilots License.
