- Ipad Mini Version 1-4 are to slow. If a Mini 5 You Really want a WHITE FACE. Black Overheats in the Sun Easily.
  Mini 6 (Recommended) Color Does Not Matter. It is all Screen.
  WiFi Version is Fine. Cellular is nice but not required (Internal GPS) Any Memory will work.
- Create an Account on FAA License Website. iacra.faa.gov
  Make sure to write down your FTN# and log in info and bring with you. Very Important!
- Log in to IACRA and apply for a Student License.
  Some find it difficult to navigate. If this is the case wait and your instructor will help you apply.
- Confirm you are not on any Medications that would hinder your FAA Medical https://www.aviationmedicine.com/medication-database/
- Create an Account on FAA Medical Website. medxpress.faa.gov
  Make sure to write down your log in info.
- o Fill out Application for Medical on Medxpress
- Text our Schedule Line to Set Up you Initial Sign Up Meeting (812) 781-8855

## What to bring to Sign Up Meeting

- o Photo ID
- Either a Valid Current US Passport or a Birth Certificate
  The TSA requires us to see and copy for proof of Citizenship prior to initiating training.
- o IACRA FTN# and Log In info.
- o Ipad Mini (If you have it. It is OK if you do not.)

## What to Complete within the first few weeks after Sign Up

- Schedule your FAA Medical Exam. Dr Greer is the only one in town. You will need a 3<sup>rd</sup> Class
  Scheduled with Deaconess. Just let them know FAA Medical (812) 858-2100
